What is the Safe Places Scheme?



The Safe Places Scheme helps people feel safe when they are outside



It supports people who may feel worried, lost or upset.



Offers a safe space to sit and calm down.

Help contact a family member, carer, friend, or support worker

Where are Safe Places?



Safe Places are buildings that make people feel safe in the community.



Places like shops, cafes and council buildings can sign up



People can:

- Look for the **Safe Place Logo**
- Go inside
- Get help straight away

Why Is It Important?



The Safe Places Scheme can make people feel safe.



It can help boost people's confidence.



It supports people's right to independence.

How Can a Venue Help?



Join the scheme as a registered venue.



Have kind staff who have been trained to know what to do if someone needs help.



They will get a **window sticker**, **postcards** and a **staff notice**.
